#### LES Job Placement Figures Ahead of Target for 2014

Our Local Employment Service (LES) continues to see over 80 clients each week in our Coolock and Kilbarrack offices to offer support with applying for jobs, writing CVs and getting training. The good news is that so far for 2014, the service is ahead of its targets for job placements. By the end of July, the service had placed 298 clients into employment, surpassing their own target of 265. To date in 2014, they have also placed 851 clients into education and training opportunities, again over achieving on their target of 660 for this stage in the year.
