To protect you and our team, before you attend your appointment, please check:


- Have you had a cough, fever, high temperature, sore throat, runny nose, breathlessness or flu-like symptoms now or in the past 14 days?

- Are you a close contact of a person who is a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days? Have you been in close proximity (less than 2 meters) for more than 15 minutes?
- Have you been advised by a doctor to self-isolate at this time?
- Have you been advised by a doctor to cocoon at this time?


The reception team will ask you to:


- Sanitize your hands using the hand gel provided at the sanitization station
- Put on a face mask which will be supplied




