



Empowering Communities Team Leader (Full-time)

Northside Partnership wishes to recruit the position of an Empowering Communities Team Leader on a full-time, fixed-term basis.

The Empowering Communities Programme (ECP) is a new programme that will use a community development approach to address social exclusion, build community leadership and work towards the alleviation of impacts of poverty in the Darndale area with a specific focus on the Electoral Division of Priorswood C. This role will provide support to the Empowering Communities Coordinator (ECC). The Team Leader will support the Empowering Communities Coordinator in line with the ECP project requirements. The Team Leader will accompany the ECC on a number of projects and provide updates on an agreed basis and record key statistics in line with project requirements and produce reports as required

Working as part of Northside Partnership's Empowering Communities Team, the Team Leader will build the capacity of a team of 5 Community Employment Health Workers. This will enable the team to take a leadership role in their community and to apply a well-coordinated community peer-led approach in responding to the health and well-being needs of people living in Darndale. The role of the Team Leader is to manage, provide support and mentor the team of CE Community Health Workers. The Team Leader will develop clear work plans to meet the health and well-being needs of people living in Darndale. The team will also be supported by the HSE Health Promotion and Improvement Officer with regard to training and development.
